

## TOWN OF TILDEN CAUCUS MINUTES

JANUARY 19, 2019 @ 1:00 P.M.

TILDEN TOWN HALL 10790 100<sup>th</sup> Avenue Chippewa Falls, WI 54729

1. Town of Tilden Chairman Daniel Adams called the Caucus to Order at 1:05 p.m. There are 14 people present and signed in the poll list. Daniel Adams asked those present if they knew how the caucus process worked and if there were any questions – no one had any questions. Daniel Adams also asked if anyone had any statements to make about anything – no one spoke.
2. Daniel Adams asked Steve Plendl, Tilden Town Clerk, to verify proper notice was made. Steve Plendl stated that notices were published in the Chippewa Herald paper, posted on the Town's website, in front of the Townhall, Recycling Center, Baier's Bar, and Bresina's Old Town Bar & Grill.
3. Daniel Adams reminded those present to sign poll list.
4. Daniel Adams explained who can participate in this caucus stating that a person must be 18 years or older, eligible to vote, and be a Town of Tilden resident
5. There was an Election of Caucus Officials with David Adams nominated to be Caucus Chairperson by Albert Goettl, seconded by Wayne Bowe. David Adams was elected by a voice vote by those present, with only ayes being heard. Two (2) Tellers were nominated; Fred Bohl by Albert Goettl, seconded by Daniel Adams and Albert Goettl by Wayne Bowe, seconded by Vernon Bowe. Both were elected by a voice vote by those present, with only ayes being heard.
6. David Adams asked how nominations for candidates would be taken. Dean Gullickson made a motion to take nominations for candidates from the floor by voice. Vernon Bowe seconded the motion. Motion passed on a vote by those present with everyone present raising their hands in agreement.
7. David Adams explained that nominations for each elected office will be made one-at-a-time.
  - a. David Adams opened nominations for Constable. Albert Goettl nominated Michael Goettl for Town of Tilden Constable. Daniel Adams seconded the nomination. David Adams asked if there were any other nominations for Constable. None were made. Nominations were closed by a unanimous voice vote of those present.
  - b. David Adams opened nominations for Treasurer. David Hartman nominated Mary Hartman. Dean Gullickson seconded the nomination. David Adams asked if there were any other nominations for Treasurer. None were made. Nominations were closed by a unanimous voice vote of those present.
  - c. David Adams opened nominations for Clerk. Michael Bowe nominated Steven Plendl. Fred Bohl seconded the nomination. David Adams asked if there were any other nominations for Clerk. None were made. Nominations were closed by a unanimous voice vote of those present.
  - d. David Adams opened nominations for Supervisor 1. Vernon Bowe nominated Daniel Reischel. Dean Gullickson seconded the nomination. David Adams asked if there were any other nominations for Supervisor 1. None were made. Nominations were closed by a unanimous voice vote of those present.

e. David Adams opened nominations for Supervisor 2. Steven Plendl nominated Wayne Bowe. Dean Gullickson seconded the nomination. David Adams asked if there were any other nominations for Supervisor 2. None were made. Nominations were closed by a unanimous voice vote of those present.

f. David Adams opened nominations for Chairperson. Albert Goettl nominated Daniel Adams. Dean Gullickson seconded the nomination. David Adams asked if there were any other nominations for Chairperson. None were made. Nominations were closed by a unanimous voice vote of those present.

8. Clerk will notify candidates and provide the required forms to be filled out by each candidate. All candidates were present and completed the required forms to be on the April 2, 2019 ballot.

9. There is at least one candidate for each of the Town's offices.

10. David Adams asked for a motion to close the Town of Tilden Caucus. Dean Gullickson made a motion to close the January 19, 2019 Town of Tilden Caucus. Vernon Bowe seconded the motion. Motion passed on a voice vote of those present with only ayes being heard. Caucus adjourned at 1:15 p.m.
