

1.0 INTRODUCTION

It was the responsibility of the Plan Commission to learn about past community changes, changes likely to occur in the future, community likes and dislikes, and to define what residents want the community to become. It studied supporting information and evaluated the Town's needs. Community participation in this process included a survey, visioning sessions and open houses. The Plan Commission is charged with the responsibility for making recommendations to the Town Board to ensure implementation of the plan is consistent with the goals and objectives of the Comprehensive Land Plan. Based on its findings, this plan makes recommendations to the Town Board regarding appropriate actions necessary to address protecting and preserving valuable Town characteristics.
