Minutes

- Daniel Adams called the monthly meeting to order at 7:35 p.m. beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance
- Daniel Adams did Roll call; Daniel Reischel – present, Wayne Bowe – present, Daniel Adams - present
- Clerk Steve Plendl verified that public notice by Town Board was posted on the Town’s website, in front of the Town Hall, at the Recycling Center, at Baier’s Bar, and at Bresina’s Old Home Bar & Grill. It was also published in the local newspaper.
- Daniel Adams asked if board members read the minutes from the Apr. 10th & 18th, 2019 Town Board Meetings. Wayne Bowe made a motion to accept the minutes from the Apr. 10th & 18th, 2019 Town Board Meetings as written. Daniel Reischel seconded the motion. Motion passed on a voice vote with only ayes being heard.
- Mary Hartman gave the Treasurer’s Report.
- Fire Department Report was given by Chief David Goettl. He said that there were several 1st responder calls and no fire calls. He also pointed out that there are fire number signs missing around the township. It appeared that they may have been knocked down by snowplowing or cut off during brushing operations. They will be replaced. 844 people attended the Annual Pancake Breakfast. David Goettl started a discussion about replacing one of the tender chassis due to age and wear. The current tender’s water tank could be placed on a new chassis. Discussion to continue next month.
- Highway Department/ Shop Maintenance Report was given by Vernon Bowe. He reported filling potholes throughout the township. There are larger areas that will require a grader patch to repair. Tires on service truck need to be replaced. No action taken. There are still a few more road signs to be put up.
- Recycling Center Report was given by Albert Goettl. He reported all is well.
- Constable’s Dog Report was given by Michael Goettl. He reported two (2) dogs picked up running at large. The dogs’ owners came and picked them up. No other calls.
- Clerk’s report was given by Steve Plendl. Five (5) building permits were issued: Justin & Mallory Eder at 9837 Co. Hwy. C for a new garage, St. Peter’s Church at 11370 Co. Hwy. Q for a buried electrical cable, Everett Fleming at 9915 129th St. for a deck replacement, Tammy Swoboda at 11537 118th Ave. for a swimming pool, and Dayton & Kris Bowe for a new home located at 8103 90th Ave. Town hall was rented twice in April and no rentals so far this month. Outstanding bills were reviewed. The c-report shows that there are a few areas of the budget to watch. The Treasure’s and Clerk’s accounts balance.

1. A discussion about contracting with Chippewa Humane Society. Daniel Reischel said that no one had contacted supporting the contract. Wayne Bowe said that the people he talked with did not support it either. After the discussion the Town Board thanked the Chippewa Humane Society for their concern.
2. Daniel Adams made a motion to grant Denise D. Supri a Bartender License. Daniel Reischel seconded the motion. Motion passed on voice vote with only ayes being heard.
3. Daniel Adams made a motion to approve Dawn Briskey’s appointment to the Tilden Plan Commission and Community Preservation Study Committee. Wayne Bowe seconded the motion. Motion passed on a voice vote with only ayes being heard.
4. After some discussion Daniel Adams made a motion to approve a utility permit for Bloomer Telephone Company to use the town’s road-right-of-way as shown on their maps and to reduce the fees by ½ as agreed. Wayne Bowe seconded the motion. Motion passed on a voice vote with only ayes being heard.
5. After some discussion a question was asked about accessing Centurylink’s new fiber optic line for high speed internet service. Clerk will ask. Daniel Adams made a motion to approve a utility permit for Centurylink as shown on their maps. Wayne Bowe seconded the motion. Motion passed on voice vote with only ayes being heard.
6. A short discussion about the Chippewa Valley Century Ride. No action was taken.
7. The County Roadside Cleanup is completed. Need only to turn in garbage and fill out paper work.
8. Road Issues:

- a. After the Road Tour by the Town Board it was determined that 115th Ave. from the intersection of 118th St. east to the town line should be pulverized and the culvert(s) replaced. Also, that 100th Ave. from the Shady Pine Bar heading east to the town line should be pulverized and the culvert(s) replaced. Both roads should sit through one winter to settle where the culverts have been replaced – paving in 2020. Daniel Adams made a motion to put an add in the newspaper requesting itemized bids for pulverizing sections of two (2) township roads: Pulverize 115th Ave. from the intersection of 118th St. then east to the Town of Tilden line and also pulverize 100th Ave. from the intersection of 102nd Ave. then east to the Town of Tilden line. Work to be completed by July 31, 2019. Bid to include recycling all existing pavement, adding three (3) inches of 1 1/4-inch diameter gravel prior to full depth pulverizing at a 24-foot width. Bids to be opened and possibly awarded at the beginning of the June 12, 2019 Town Board meeting. Daniel Reischel seconded the motion. Motion passed on a voice vote with only ayes being heard.
 - b. Culvert work to be addressed at the June 12, 2019 Town Board meeting.
9. No action taken on solid waste & recycling contract.
10. Annual Town Meeting April 16, 2019 was attended by 11 town's people. Minutes are post at townoftilden.com for public review.
11. Tilden's Open Book took place on April 26th, 2019. One couple came and asked a question about their home and property's valuation. The assessor, Randy Prochnow, answered their question.
12. Public comment
 - a. Albert Goettl discussed Tilden's Comprehensive Land Use Plan update.
 - b. Steve Plendl asked about were a duplex can be built.
 - c. Daniel Adams said that there are 10 people with 18 dogs left to be licensed. He gave the list to Michael Goettl for follow up.
 - d. Mary Hartman pointed out the paint on the town hall's east and north sides was peeling and the painter should be contacted. Painted in 2016 and should last longer.
 - e. Daniel Reischel asked Fire Chief David Goettl about buying a used tender chassis.
13. Daniel Adams made a motion to approve the vouchers and transfer funds to pay the bills. Wayne Bowe seconded the motion. Motion passed on a voice vote with only ayes being heard.
14. Reminder read to all present: Board of Review Thursday May 23rd, 2019 from 7 p.m. till 9 p.m.
